## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show will open at 9.00 am.
2. Dogs will be received until 11.00 a.m. after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management
3. All judging will commence at 10.00am.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **Entry Fees: Members** - £7.00 First Entry per dog; £3.50 each subsequent entry. **Non-Members** - £7.50 First Entry per dog; £4.00 each subsequent entry for that dog. ***IF ENTERING FOR STAKES CLASSES ONLY – ENTRY MUST BE PAID AS FIRST ENTRY.***  
Handling Classes @ £2.00 per class. Handlin Class @ £2.50; Not For Competition - £2.00 per Dog. ***Where a dog which is owned in partnership is entered at members' rates, All those within the partnership must be members of the society***  
**Catalogue** - £4.00 with entries. **Membership** - £2.50 Single / £3.00 Joint.  
**Advertisements** – Full Page £10.00 / Half Page £6.00.

7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries
8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
16. **Best Puppy in Show**
17. Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in Show respectively.  
**Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:**
  - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
  - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
  - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.**Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.**

### **Best in Show**

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.

#### **Shows Judged on the Group System**

(Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and require a judge to declare a best of each group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)

##### **1) Best of Breed**

Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

##### **2) Best of Group**

Best of group and subsequent placings must be selected from:-

- a) The Best of Breed winners in each group
- b) The Best dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group
- c) The Best dog from Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group

##### **3) Best in Show**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining group winners following the selection for Best in Show.

19.

Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

20.

Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.

21.

All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

22.

All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

23.

#### **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and The Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the

route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

24. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under The Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
25. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
26. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.
27. The Committee will use every effort to ensure that all exhibits are brought before the judges but will not accept responsibility if the exhibit is absent when called for by the Ring Steward.
28. Should any question arise not provided for in these Rules & Regulations the decision of the Committee will be final, subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.
29. Every exhibitor making entries for this Show is deemed to have agreed to abide by Kennel Club Rules & Show Regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries received.
30. You are required to clear up any fouling by your dog. Any infringement of this regulation will be reported to the Show Manager who will take such action as is seen fit.
31. The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of dogs brought for exhibition but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and purchasers of dogs and all other persons that the Committee will NOT be responsible for the entire or partial loss or detention of or damage to a dog or any other property whether arising



from accident or any other cause, whatsoever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants, agents or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

32. No animal, other than an exhibit duly entered at the Show, will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance.
33. The Committee of this show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition. (K.C.S.R.(F)).
34. Your name and address will be held on a Computer Data Base. This will be used for the Society's records only and for mandatory annual returns to the Kennel Club. If you object please notify the Secretary in writing.

### **DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES**

In the following Definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials, each partner must at the time of entry be a Member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entered for any class, i.e. **3<sup>rd</sup> JUNE 2024**.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes, but when entering for Variety Classes, wins in both Breed and Variety Classes must be counted. A Variety Class is one in which more than one Breed or a Variety of a Breed can compete. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options: (1) Withdrawal: The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

(2) Transfer: (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, sex, weight or height.

(b) If an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, sex, weight or height or in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, sex, weight or height.

(c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, sex, weight or height.

(d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. **JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. **YEARLING:** For dogs of 12 and not exceeding 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate / CACIB / CAC / Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate / CACIB / CAC / Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT:** For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CACIB / CAC / Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN:** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN:** For dogs not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

**SPECIAL YEARLING:** For dogs of 6 and not exceeding 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS:** For dog, handler & owner never to have won a Challenge Certificate in the Breed. **CHAMPION CLASS:** For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion. Champion classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds.

**IMPORTED BREED REGISTER:** For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, with the winning dog being eligible for Best in Group, Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show as relevant. **ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED:** For breeds of dog for which NO separate breed classes are scheduled.

**GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS:** For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Societies may at their discretion accept NOT for Competition Entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. **Puppies under four months of age are not eligible for entry NOT FOR COMPETITION. ALL DOGS ENTERED N.F.C. MUST BE K.C. REGISTERED.**

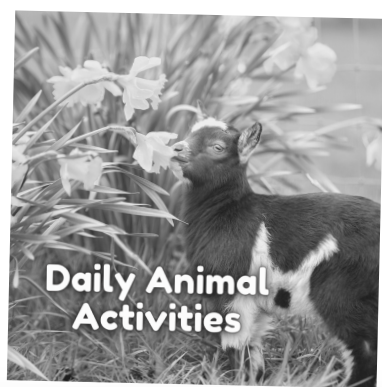
